Managing Director of the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, Amsterdam since March 2021, Winterling's previous positions include as Managing Director of the Stiftung Elbphilharmonie, and lead roles in Finance, Marketing, Business Organisation, and Artistic Planning at the Heidelberger Frühling Music Festival. He joins the governing body of the Grafenegg-based EUYO's operational activity, chaired by Intendantin-Designate of the Cologne Philharmonie **Ewa Bogusz-Moore**.
